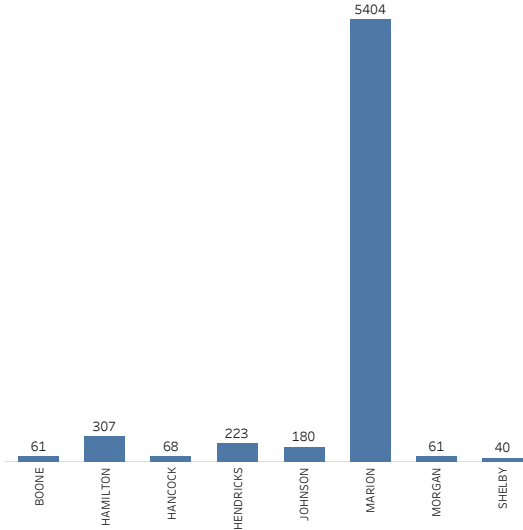

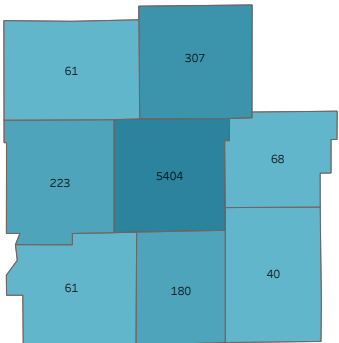

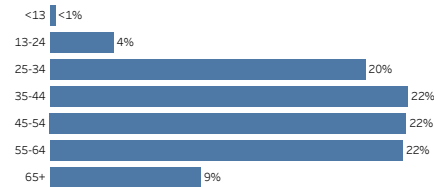

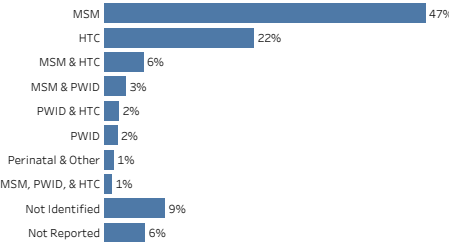

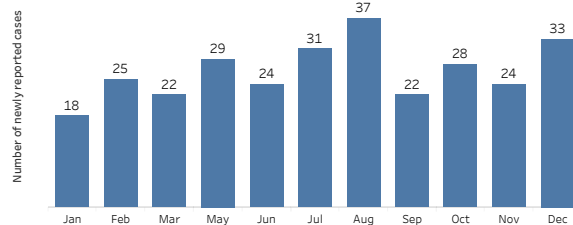

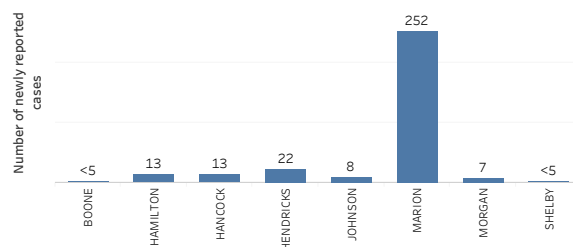
### Zip Coalition 7 Newly Reported Cases of Diagnosed HIV/AIDS 2022

By Month of Diagnosis



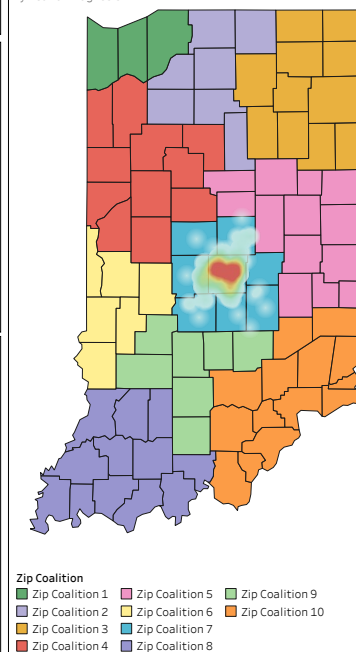

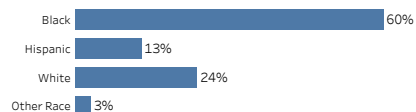

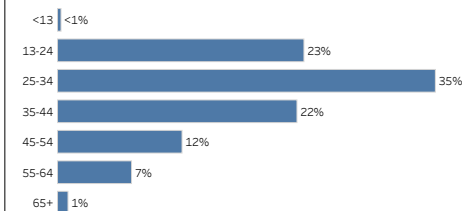

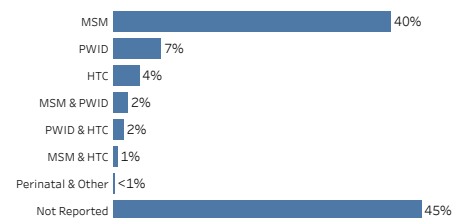

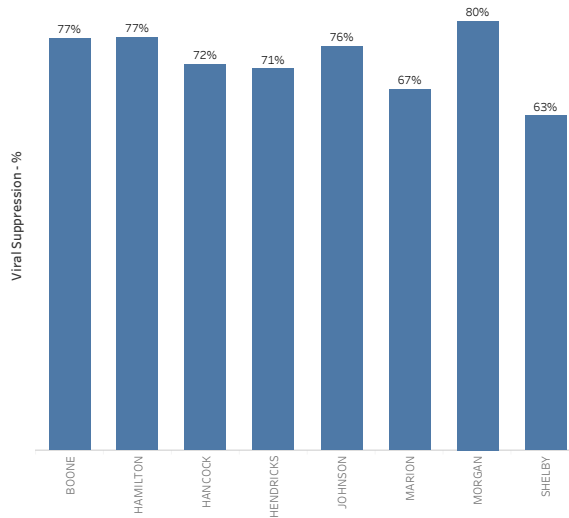

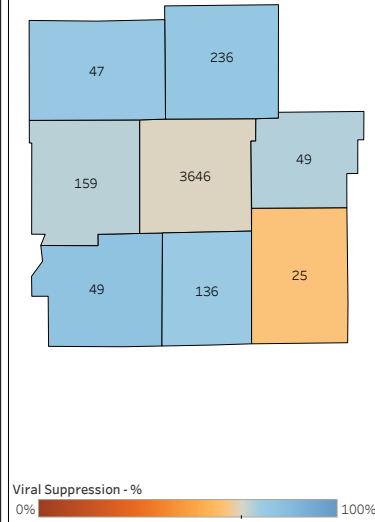

Viral Suppression Distribution by County



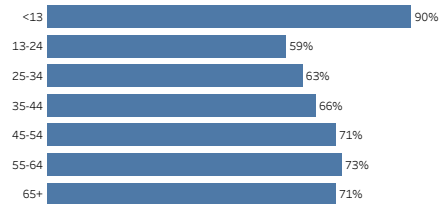

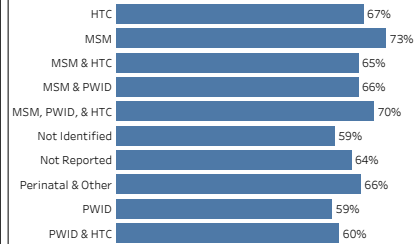

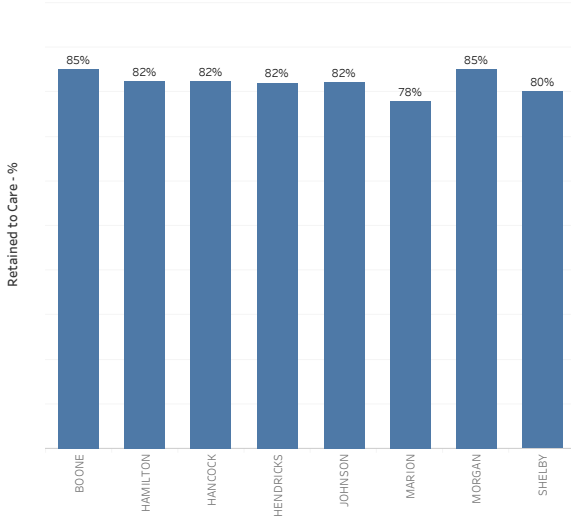

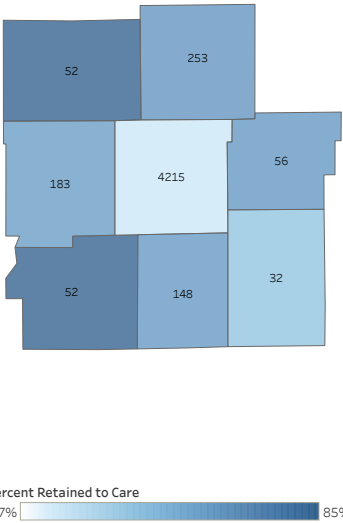
